
Important Information To Share For Now



Welcome Booklet (also available to download on website) hopefully answers most of your questions. On top of that, a word on the following:



Before the First Day



- Shoes, school bag and jackets

The First Few Days and Weeks



First two weeks of school (School re-opens on Friday 1 September 2023)

The Junior Infants are to be dropped at the external classroom door (Room 2) by a parent/guardian for the first week. They are to be dropped at the gate from week two onwards.

For the <u>first two weeks</u>, Junior Infants will finish at 12:00pm. This will be up to and including Friday 15 September 2023. Parents will line up outside the external classroom door on pavement dots. The teacher will send your son to you when you are at the front of the line. Please do not call your son to come to you.


From Monday 18 September onwards, Junior Infants finish at 2:00pm and will be collected at the external classroom door as per week one and two.

Please make sure your son is collected on time.


If you are upset, try not to show it. Leave your child with the teacher and tell him that you will be back to collect him at 12pm/2pm If your child is upset, trust the teacher.
