### *Soccer Munster Finals in Tralee*

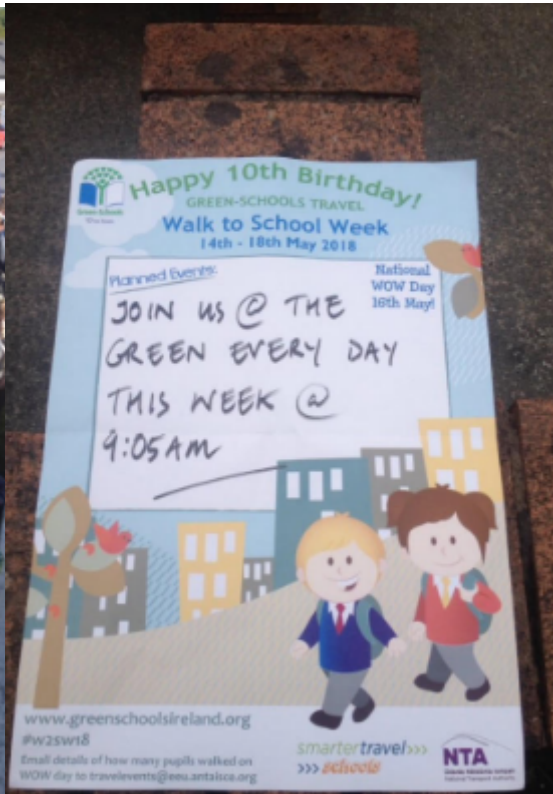
The boys had a great day making it to the soccer final in Tralee. Well done to all involved as it was a long trip.
