Numeracy	Revise counting to ten	Count to ten stamping feet in time with the numbers. Count backwards from ten tapping shoulders in time with the numbers. When counting, stop (your son) at various different numbers and ask him the number that comes before and after that number. Ask you son to get you different quantities of items,e.g. Five toy cars, six Lego blocks etc. Ask your son to close his eyes and drop some coins into a cup, one by one (No more than ten). Ask him to open his eyes and identify how many coins in the cup before counting the coins together.
