Stationery:

- 2 large tubes of Pritt Stick (Keep one at home until school one needs replacing)
- 2 Faber Castell Junior triangular pencils (red in colour)
- 1 Small Eraser
- 2 x Whiteboard markers (Show-me drywipe marker black or similar narrow width)
- 1 packet of crayola 24 thin crayons
- 1 pencil case to hold colours and writing stationary.
- 1 tub of playdough (labelled)
- 2 A4 Mesh Plastic Folders (Texet A4 mesh bag) (This A4 mesh zip bag is a mesh folder with a zip on top & is in stock in AM Office Supplies. ➡)
