This week boys you are looking for containers that hold liquid.

Liquid is measured in millilitres and litres.

1000ml = 1 litre ( 1 litre of milk)

#### Fun in the sink with water

Take some empty containers from your recycling and fill some with different amounts of water and decide which are empty, nearly empty, full and nearly full.

#### Find containers that hold liquid

Next go to the kitchen and take two containers of liquid at a time and decide which holds more and which holds less and record your answers.

(Estimation work)

If it is possible then and if it is ok with your parents use a measuring jug to measure the liquids in each container and see if your estimations were correct. Offline

#### **ROV - Remotely Operated Vehicle**

An ROV is a Remotely Operated Vehicle, a tool used to explore our oceans. It is controlled by an ROV operator on-board the ship and sends live video of what it is seeing back to the control room. This type of equipment was used to explore the Titanic wreckage.

This week you are going to explore the depths of the ocean and draw and colour what you found with your ROV. Perhaps you found treasure, a shipwreck or some undiscovered species. Let your imagination go wild!



The first link will bring you to an information page about ROVs, there is also a game that you can play with your family and a ROV art sheet which is part of your art activities this week.


The second link will show you a video taken by a ROV of the titanic and shows you what the titanic looks like now at the bottom of the Atlantic Ocean.




